ACCELERATED READER

The students at Hill-Roberts are very lucky to have the Accelerated Reader program at our school. All students take the STAR Reader quiz which determines their level. Books in our library are coded with a system of circular tags (see the link entitled "Reading Levels"). We have two versions that our students use:

Desk top version

Who Uses It? All 2nd grade students and Kindergarten & 1st grade students as they are recommended by their teachers.

What books and quizzes are available? We have approximately 1600 quizzes available to students. Use the links on the Library website to see what we own. You can search the list by title, author or the level your student is reading

On-Line Version

Thanks to our PTO we have 250 licenses for this version. Students have accessibility to over 100,000 quizzes! Books from the school library and home can be read. Wondering if there is a quiz available???? Use the "AR Book Finder" link and enter the title, author or other information to see the book level and quiz availability.

Who Uses It? All 3rd and 4th grade students and any K, 1st or 2nd grader reading at a 3rd grade level or above, depending on space.
